		This year's Motto will be "World's Best" and the greatest ice skaters from all over the world will be there. The show will start with the newcomer Tomi Pulkinnen from Switzerland.
10:02:13		Another important name in that field is Sarah Meier: the 27- year old Swiss won the European championship this Winter. Though she has an excellent reputation, she lately announced her resignation of participation in competitions.

It is essential that children spend a lot of time on ice, so that they collect miles on ice and get a feeling for it.

We can do a lot more here and be much more inventive, as it would be in a competition. As we don't have this stress-situation here, we can, for example, use this door here and integrate it in our program. We can be more extroverted and, this again, is ideal for the amusement of the audience.)
10:08:17		From china: the couple Xue Shen and Hongbo Zhao, married since 2007. Together, they have achieved Olympic Gold and three world championship titles.

10:09:10		Ranging from traditional Chinese music to modern pop, the ice gala Davos is covering a large musical spectrum. Not to forget our hosts, the brothers Volker and Thomas Martins, better known as chaos theatre oropax, will lead through our show in a more than humorous way.
10:09:35	Original-Ton des Comedy-Acts	Ain't it depressing, Thomas, that one of us has just made a fool of himself in front of more than 5000 people? What? Give me a hint? One of us, but it's





		not me. One of us, but it's not you? That's a rule of proportion; I've never been good at maths.
10:10:30		Approximately 9000 people were present on the two days of performances and could attend this spectacular show. The audience honours our ice skating stars with an exultant applause.
