5,500 people from 90 different nations gathered in Astana, the capital of the republic of Kazakhstan, to discuss the global economy at the 5th Astana Economic Forum from 22nd to 24th of May. The event was created from Kazakhstan's President Nursultan Nazarbayev five years ago. Eleven Nobel Prize Winners participated and addressed the issue of global crisis.

The platform for dialogue included scientists, scholars, experts and political leaders from all over the world. They exchanged ideas, experiences and knowledge at a critical time for the world's economic future. The president of Kazakhstan calls for partnership of civilizations to resolve the global problems of humanity.
